COURSE DESCRIPTION

One of the main objectives of the Qur'an is to outline the ethics and conduct that are befitting of the believer. Surah al-Hujurat is just that. Beginning with what proper conduct before Allah is, the Surah goes on to tell us of the rank and wisdom of the Messenger of Allah ﷺ; how believers should be towards him ﷺ; and the immense blessings of faith, guidance, and obedience.

The focus of the Surah then shifts to our conduct with our fellow brothers and sisters. We learn to confirm what we hear before judging and acting, and how to be just and merciful to believers should they have a dispute amongst themselves. Mockery, name-calling, spying, and backbiting are also addressed due to the extremely detrimental effect they have on relations.

Introduction

- It is from the traditions of our pious predecessors that they would study the hadith about a time which they were currently dealing with.
 - For this reason, it is important to study the hadith on Ramadan during this blessed month.
- Imam Yousuf Al-Nabhani is a scholar from the past century who gathered
- There are different types of hadith works:
 - Primary hadith works are those that have the chain of hadith mentioned.
 - These include the works of Bukhari, Tirmidhi, etc.
 - Scholars that came after these primary scholars compiled the hadith into books without the chains so that it was easier to read.
- Imam Al-Nabhani prepared 40 books on on different topics and gathered 40 ahadith on each topic.
 - This course will cover his 40 hadith on Ramadan.
- The Prophet SAW said: The person of my ummah who memorizes and acts on 40 hadith gets a specific reward.
 - There is emphasis on 40 hadiths because it is an amount which is not extremely difficult to learn.
 - For this reason, scholars have attempted to gather different collections of 40 hadith.

RAMADAN IMMERSION

Introduction

- Surah Taha can be broken down into four themes.
 - The first of these themes is: *The Power of the Words of Allah SWT*

Verse 1

Taa Haa

- Scholars mention that this is a name of the Prophet SAW.
 - Allah never calls upon the Prophet SAW by his name directly in the Quran, unlike He did for other prophets.
 - It is out of the respect and love of Allah for the Prophet SAW that He calls him by other names.
- This grabs the attention of the Prophet SAW because something important will be mentioned soon after.

Verse 2

مَا أَنْزَلْنَا عَلَيْكَ الْقُرْآنَ بِتَشْوِيٍّ

We did not reveal the Quran to you to make you suffer.

- The Prophet SAW would engage with the Quran to such an extent that his body would become weak.
- Allah mentioned in Surah Al-Qiyamah:
 - لَا تُحَرِّكْ بِهِ لِسَانَكَ لِتُحْضِرَ بِهِ (70:16) إِنَّ عَلَيْنَا جُمُوعَةَ الْقُرْآنِ (70:17)

Do not rush your tongue trying to memorize a revelation of the Quran, (70:16) It is certainly upon Us to make you memorize and recite it, (75:17)


And! prostrated you for Mosaic (41)
